Fundamental Principles in the Grammar of Rabbi Jonah ibn Janāḥ — Summary Elnatan Chen

In the context of R. Jonah Ibn Janāḥ's systematic categorization, according to their roots and stems, of weak verb forms in the Bible, especially in the Book of Criticism (*Kitāb al-Mustalḥaq*) and the Book of Roots (*Kitāb al-Uṣūl*), there are identifiable attempts to adhere to a number of general fundamental principles which appear extensively in his compositions, sometimes explicitly, sometimes implicitly from the context. In my lecture I will particularize these principles, their usage, and how Ibn Janāḥ handles them when two or more principles conflict with each other.
